Special News from the Capital Region: Are you aware there is an initiative in the Capital Region (so called, as it will encompass the 11 Surrounding Counties = Albany, Columbia, Fulton, Greene, Montgomery, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Schenectady, Schoharie, Warren and Washington), called the "LEGACY PROJECT".

It will be a "Landmark" destination for our Capital Region and will include a Welcome Center and Veterans Café. This Café will be an integral part of the facility and is intended to be a place where Veterans, their families and the public can relax, make friends and obtain information.


