From 1989 to 1992, Mary was appointed Deputy Director of the Eastern Region of the Veterans Affairs. In 1992, Mary was then appointed Deputy Director of the Western Region of the Veterans Affairs.

Tri-County Council Vietnam Era Veterans, met Mary in the summer of 1989 while TCCVEV was constructing the Albany County Vietnam Memorial. During discussions, Mary offered to be part of the Memorial Committee. She volunteered to take on the task of researching the names to be included on the Memorial Tablet to insure that the names submitted were, in fact, ALL Albany County residents. This laborious undertaking took on many challenges, including verification of a Canadian, Donald Davies, who entered the U.S. through Albany, NY, where he enlisted.

Mary, was very active in Tri-County direction and she was also a strong advocate for women veterans. The last time Mary was in Albany was for TCCVEV's 35th Anniversary Celebration. She will be greatly missed by Tri-County and the veteran community.
